KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Wong E. Jackson and Debra A. Jackson his wife, do hereby convey to Southland Trans. Inc., State of South Carolina, hereinafter whether one or more called the "Mortgagor", has become justly indebted to the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the "Mortgagee", in the sum of Seven Thousand and 68/100 Dollars (\$7,000.68), evidenced by a promissory note of even date hereinafter in the total amount set forth above, payable in monthly installments the first installment being \$107.19 and the remaining installments being \$107.19 each with any unpaid balance due on the final payment due date, the first installment of which is due on the day of July 1980.

Wong Edward Jackson and Debra Ann Reid, their heirs and assigns forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, located in the northern side of Pacific avenue, being known and designated as Lot 320 on plat Book of Pleasant Valley said plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P, Page 114 and having according to a more recent survey prepared by Carolina Surveying Company entitled "Property of Wong Edward Jackson and Debra Ann Reid" recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 6-T, Page 62 the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Pacific Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots 320 and 321 and running thence N. 0-08 W., 147 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said Lots; thence along the rear of Lot 320 N. 49-52 E., 16.6 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Phoenix Avenue; thence along the western side of Phoenix Avenue, thence along the western side of Phoenix Avenue S. 24-31 E., 136.2 feet to an iron pin, thence continuing along the western side of Phoenix Avenue S. 32-0 W., 27.4 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Pacific Avenue; thence along the northern side of Pacific Avenue S. 49-52 W., 57.3 feet to an iron pin, being the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to all easements, restrictions, rights-of-way, including road rights-of-way, zoning ordinances, if any appearing of record affecting this property.
