Burbage as shown by plat prepared by J. Mac Richardson, October 1958 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a public road separating the property of M. L. Burbage; thence along that line N. 68-57 W., 138 feet to an iron pin in the center of a branch thence continuing along the branch traverse line being N. 51-02 W., 138 feet; N. 67-14 W., 91 feet; N. 59-21 W., 116 feet; N. 58-45 W., 70 feet; N. 89-56 W., 60 feet; N. 57-58 W., 87 feet; S. 61-26 W., 76.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 6-18 E., 296.6 feet along the line of the other property owned by Mrs. Burbage to an iron pin in the center of an unnamed public road; thence down the center of said unnamed public road N. 19-20 E., 365 feet to an iron pin in the center of intersection of said unnamed road and Harrison Bridge Road; thence down the center of Harrison Bridge Road S. 81-47 E., 650 feet to the point of beginning containing 11.8 acres, more or less.
