premises and will pay any debt, claim or other charge for repairs or improvements that may have been made or may hereafter be made on, and which may become a lien against, the premises or any part thereof, and will not permit any lien or encumbrance of any kind which may be or become superior to this mortgage to accrue or remain on the premises or any part thereof; in the event of default hereunder the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary or complete the construction work and charge the expenses for such repairs or for the completion of construction to the mortgage debt and/or declare the indebtedness secured hereby due and payable.

7. That the Mortgagor, at the option of the Mortgagee, will pay to the Mortgagee all moneys received as compensation for the taking of the premises or any part thereof virtue of the right of eminent domain or in any other manner whatsoever and all moneys received as damages for injury sustained by the premises or any part thereof and in any such event, the Mortgagee may, if in its sole discretion it determines that its security is impaired, elect to declare the whole of the remaining indebtedness, if any, immediately due and payable. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, in the event that there has not been any event of default by the Mortgagor under the Secured Obligations during the twelve (12) month period preceeding the date of such taking or injury, and that the Mortgagor demonstrates to the Mortgagee, to the Mortgagoe's satisfaction, that such moneys are adequate, or that Mortgagor has available additional sufficient
