NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) by the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about seven miles northeast of the City of Greenville, on or near the Old Spartanburg Highway and being forty (40) lots on plat of C. D. Jones dated January, 1958, said plat to be recorded. This is a portion of a certain subdivision known as Terrace Gardens conveyed to me by deed of J. I. Hightower dated November 21, 1954.
