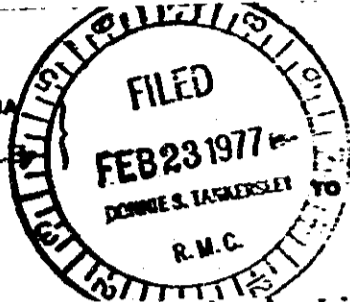

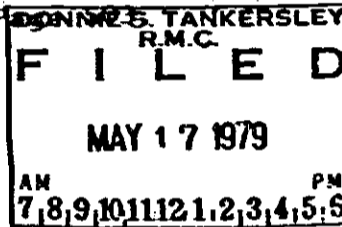
WHEREAS, I, the said Dorothy A. Livingston

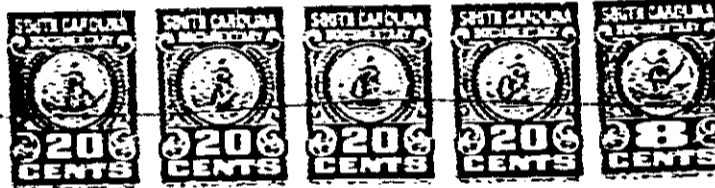
