C., the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, (I) (we) hereby grant unto said City of Greenville, a right-of-way or easement along, over or under (my) (our) property for the purpose of:

Installing and maintaining a storm drain line with junction boxes, said right-of-way to be 20 feet wide during construction and a permanent right-of-way of 5 feet on each side of the said storm drain line as installed and being 300 feet more or less in length.

The owner reserves the right to make connections to said storm sewer and extend such connections within the limits of his property as desired.

Together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.

Said property is described as follows:

Located in the city of Greenville being situated on the west side of South Main Street and shown as Lot 14, Block 1, Sheet 89 on the County Block Book.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the right to the City of Greenville, S. C., its successors and assigns. And (we) (I) do hereby bind (ourselves) (myself), (our) (my) heirs, successors or administrators or assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the Grantee herein.
