Dear Mr. Moon:

We hand you herewith for recordation the deed of J. T. Woodside to the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, as Trustee.

In our opinion this deed is not subject to the Documentary Stamp Tax as the bank is holding same for the benefit of J. T. Woodside. However, we wish to have the Tax Commission definitely pass upon the question and we guarantee that in the event they do not agree with us and should require stamps to be placed upon the deed that same will be placed thereupon on the basis of \$60,000.00, to-wit, \$120.00 in South Carolina Documentary Stamps.

We shall certainly appreciate your seeing that this deed is not given for publication to the newspapers.

We will communicate further with you as soon as our Mr. C. F. Haynsworth has heard from the South Carolina Tax Commission.
