Dear Mr. Farnsworth:

This refers to our letter to you dated September 6, 1961 with which we handed you deed, lease and assignment for recordation.

In accordance with your request, we have had the affidavit concerning the deed and the forms stamped on the lease and assignment properly completed and enclose the deed, lease and assignment for recordation.

(1) Enclosed herewith is our check being in the amount of \$268.25 which represents recording fees of \$25.25 and South Carolina Documentary Stamps of \$242.00 (which amount was computed upon the basis of \$1.00 per \$500.00 consideration, with the total consideration for the deed being \$120,753.93) plus postage of \$1.00.

(2) We are advised that on the basis of a ruling of the Internal Revenue Service the transaction, on which the deed in question is a part, is not subject to the tax which is imposed by the Federal Documentary Stamp Act.

It would be appreciated if you would go ahead and record the above instruments and return the same to us at the earliest possible date. We certainly appreciate the kind consideration which you have given us in this matter.
