PERSONALLY appeared before me E. P. Riley, who being first duly sworn, states that he is attorney for the School District of Greenville County and as such, was called on to the title to examine/a piece of property on E Street. The School Board was desiring to purchase a small triangular shaped piece off of this lot. The School District agreed to pay net to the Grantor the sum of TWO HUNDRED and NO/100 (\$200.00) Dollars.
