Mrs. N.S. Neilson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. N.S. Neilson, an interest equal to one-half of the whole in fee to and in that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, having the following lines, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on the North side of a fifteen foot alley; thence North 65 degrees East 156 feet to iron pin; thence North 15 degrees 01 minute West 67 feet to iron pin to dividing lines of lots 4-5-6-7; thence South 68 degrees 50 minutes West 155 feet to iron pin on Manley Street, then with Manly Street South 15 degrees 01 minute East 74-1/2 feet to beginning corner, being the lot conveyed to me by Jas. A. Finlay.
