acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
George F. Alexander, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situated in the County and State aforesaid,
in or near the City of Greer having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on Fairview
Avenue, corner of lot #1, and runs thence with said Avenue fifty-five and five tenths feet to the
corner of lot #3; thence along the line of lot Number three one hundred eighty-four and three tenths
feet; thence along the line of lot #5, fifty-four and seventenths feet to the corner of lot #1; thence
along the line of lot #1, one hundred and Ninety-three and nine tenths to the beginning corner, being
