KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That James B. Watkins, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid
 for the sum of Four thousand Dollars

to me in hand delivered before the sealing of these presents by

John L. Watkins, of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), for Grantees Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John L. Watkins his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and having the following lines and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the corner of Brinscombe Road (iron pin on East side) W.C. Cleveland's corner and running; thence with Brinscombe Road S. 15.30 W. 1120 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64.15 E. 825 feet to an iron pin; then N. 29.30 E. 748 feet to an iron pin on common line between W.F. Thackston and W.C. Cleveland, deceased; thence with Cleveland's line N. 45.50 W. 344 feet to an oak-tree; thence continuing with said line N. 45.50 W. 766 feet to beginning corner and containing twenty (20) acres, more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by W.F. Thackston, deceased, by deed dated October 11th, 1906 and recorded in R.M.C for Greenville County in Book TTT, page 87.

TOGETHER WITH all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident thereto.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

John L. Watkins, and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I, by this Deed bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said John L. Watkins, his

heirs and assigns, and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
