KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Leila V. Armstrong of Barnwell County

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00)

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mary E. Turpin

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

transferred, assigned and set over and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, transfer, assign and set over and forever quit-claim unto the said Mary E. Turpin, all my right title, interest, estate, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity in the estate, both real and personal, of the said Rosa A. Turpin, deceased, including particularly all of the undivided estate of the said Rosa A. Turpin, deceased in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, on the West side of Jones Street, in the City of Greenville, containing 7095 square feet, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning on a stake 3XN on said Street; thence N. 49 W. 129 feet to a stake 3XM; thence S. 41 W. 55 feet to stake 3XN, thence S. 49 E. 129 feet to a stake 3XN on said Jones Street; thence along West side of same N. 41 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same lot of land conveyed by Earle Turpin to Rosa A. Turpin, Mary E. Turpin, Leila V. Turpin by a deed bearing date April 28, 1898, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, South Carolina, on September 6, 1900, in Book GGG of Deeds at page 307; and being the same lot of land conveyed to the said Earle Turpin by Waddy H. Hudson by a deed bearing date November 24, 1890, and recorded in the above named office on December 10, 1890, in book WW. of Deeds, at page 447, it being fully understood and agreed that I the said Leila V. Armstrong already own an undivided interest in said tract of land under the deed of Earle Turpin hereinabove referred to; and that I still retain my said undivided interest therein so derived and I only convey to the said Mary E. Turpin my share of the undivided interest in said land which formerly belonged to the said Rosa A. Turpin, deceased.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said

Mary E. Turpin, her heirs, executors, administrators

AND do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

heirs and assigns, against and heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

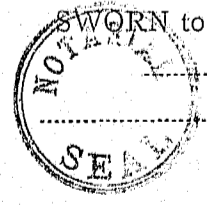
