

J.M. Fortner DEED TO Cleveland and Williams

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.M. Fortner of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Cleveland & Williams (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Cleveland and Williams, all that certain, lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the sixth Ward of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Sullivan St. at a corner of a lot of land formerly belonging to the estate of G.A. Norwood, deceased, and running; thence along the said Sullivan St. S. 88.75 E. sixty feet (60) to a stake; thence along line of lot owned by Cleveland & Williams N. 1.25 W. being at a right angle with Sullivan St. two hundred and eight feet to a stake; thence N. 69 W. sixty feet (60) to a stake on line of lot formerly belonging to the estate of G.A. Norwood, deceased; thence in a straight line with said Norwood line to the beginning corner. This being a portion of the lot of land conveyed to Elias Allen by Daniel Jerido by a deed bearing date June 13th, 1878, and recorded in R.M.C office for Greenville County South Carolina, August 14th, 1878 in Book II of deeds, page 752, and being the western portion of lot conveyed by W.O. Groce to J.M. Fortner, Sept. 10th, 1910.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Cleveland & Williams, its successors and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Cleveland & Williams, its successors

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
