(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Henry Bull, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and Being in Ward one of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on the South side of a 30 foot Street, running West from Townes Street, and 238 feet from the Southeast corner of said Alley & Townes Street and running; thence with said 30 foot Street or Alley N. 66-1/2 W. 45 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 4; thence with the line of lot No. 4, S. 23-1/2 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 66-1/2 E. 45 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 2; thence with the line of lot No. 2 N. 23-1/2 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being designated as lot No. 3 on plat made by J.R.
