(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Gossett, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, known as lot number 57 of Morgan Hill Addition according to a plat recorded in plat book A, page 69 in the office of the Register of Mesne of Conveyances for said Greenville County.
