to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

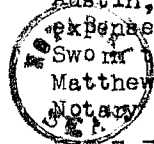
A.C. Davis (the receipt whereof

lots of Andy Harris and A.C. Davis, containing one-fourth of an acre, more or less and being
