in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000) & no, 00 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J. M. Griffin

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. M. Griffin: All that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining the Hicks, Garrison and other lands owned by Emma F. Rhodes, containing thirty and one fourth acres, more or less, beginning at a stone next to the Hicks land and running thence S. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.00 to W. O. 3x, thence S. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.67 to a stone, thence S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 54.50 to the Creek, thence N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.80 to a stone, thence N. 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.34 to the beginning corner.Also all that other tract of land in the same section of said County and State, containing twenty six and three-fourths acres, more or less, adjoining the B. S.
