R.P. Pitman (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

R.P. Pitman, all that piece or parcel of land containing Five acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Harris Pitman, R.P. Pitman and others:

Commencing and beginning on an Ash thence S.W. to a branch on bank of branch, thence down the branch to a Honey Locust, thence across the creek to a stone, thence East to a sour-wood, thence on R.P. Pitmans line to a stone, thence to North-west to be ginning corner

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said R.P. Pitman, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said R.P. Pitman, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
