in consideration of the sum of Seventy and 00/100 Dollars (\$70.00) DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Sallie D. Olson

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Sallie D. Olson, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina, and in Greenville Township near ... Morgan Mills; being of a triangular shape and cut off from lots No. 5 and No. 6 of a ... division of land known as Morgan-Hill as represented by plat recorded in R.M.C. office at Greenville, S.C. in Plat Book "A" at page 68, said lot fronting on Oneal Street thirty-eight feet, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at corner of lot No. 7 and running along Oneal Street S. 82-3/4 W. 38 feet to an iron pin; thence on a line (diagonal) N.E. - - - feet to iron pin on lower corner of lot No. 5; thence S. 7-1/4 E. 127 feet (given on a plat as 125 feet) to the beginning corner on Oneal Street.

This lot is a portion cut off from lots No. 5 and No. 6, which said lots were conveyed to W.P. Smith by M.W. Morgan and conveyed to me by W.P. Smith by deed bearing date March 4th, 1905 and recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Book "N.N.N", page 720
