is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Robert L. Campbell all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in State
of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Dunklin Township, on branches of Horse Creek, waters
of Reedy River, containing Sixteen and thirty-five one hundredth (16.35) acres, more or less.
Beginning at new corner on old line of Robert L. Campbell's thence S. 47-1/8 E. 6.86 to stone
XIII O, thence S. 41-1/2 E. 5.16 to stone XII O, thence S. 33-1/4 E. 11.42 to stone XIII O. on
