in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Four hundred & no/100 DOLLARS.
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

E.M. Hightower (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E.M. Hightower, that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County
and State aforesaid and in Highland Township, and on the South side of Pax Mountain, having the
following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone corner on M.L. Brown, line thence along
said line in a southerly to rock corner, thence in an easterly direction to stone corner, thence
in a northerly direction to stone corner, thence in a North-easterly direction to stone corner,
thence in northerly direction to Hollow, thence in North-westerly direction up Hollow to beginning
corner, containing 14 acres, more or less. Bounded by lands as follows on West by M.L. Brown on
South & East by T.I. Brown on North by A.L. Hightower. See Plat for location of said land.
