KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville Real Estate, Loan and Insurance Company a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifteen and 6/100 (\$215.65), DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto S. A. Curry,

and his heirs and assigns forever: - All that certain lot of land, lying and being in the town of Simpsonville, State and County aforesaid, and beginning at the center of Railroad tract, J. R. Blakely's corner and running thence with New Cut Road, two hundred (200) feet to stake in center of said road; thence South 87.3 feet to stake, corner of lot no. 3; thence East two hundred (200) feet to center of Railroad tract; thence North 93.3 feet to beginning corner, being lot no. 4 of Plat made by F. G. Rogers, Engineer, April 4th, 1910, and containing about one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and being a part of the tract of five (5) acres, conveyed to the Greenville Real Estate, Loan and Insurance Company by J. TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

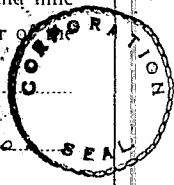
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns forever.
