

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred no/oo DOLLARS,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mr. W.

White and Josephine White all that piece bounded on lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville County, South Carolina, about one and one-half miles from the City of Greenville near the Southern Railway, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin three hundred seven feet from the northwest corner of Goldsmith and Henry Street corner of lot No. 67 on West Remington referred to, a line running thence N. 48-30 E. one hundred eighty-three feet to an iron pin on a fourteen-foot alley, thence with said alley N. 41-30 E. sixty-one feet to the beginning corner, being lot No. 66 on front of Capwood made by J. E. Birne March 6, 1906, devised December 17th, 1918 and recorded in office of Register Deed Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book U. page 424.
