KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Carolina Land & Trust Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Six Hundred Dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

M. E. Burns, All that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid being one of the lots conveyed to the grantor by the heirs at law of John H. Earle, deceased, deed recorded in Vol 52 page 105 in P.M. office of Greenville County, said lot has the following metes and bounds, Beginning one hundred forty seven and one half feet from an iron pin, corner of lot of Susan Mitchell in Birne Street and running thence parallel with Birne Street N 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ E Sixty six (66) feet eight inches to an iron pin in line of Susan Mitchell's lot thence South 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ E Seventy (70) feet to an iron pin in corner of above lot thence 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ S Sixty six (66) feet eight inches to an iron pin in corner lot formerly known as T. & McDonald's lot N 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 70 feet to the beginning corner.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and M. E. Burns, his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof:
