DEED TO Harold D. Burgess

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

The Quickbuilt Home Corporation

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Harold D. Burgess: All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the county and State aforesaid in the city of Greenville on the west side of North Main Street and having the following limits and boundaries: Beginning at an iron post on the west side of North Main Street and running thence along said street N. 18 E. 60 feet to corner of property now or formerly belonging to Endell; thence N. 72 W. 130 feet to an iron post on a ten foot alley, thence along the eastern side of said alley S. 18 W. 60 feet to an iron post; thence S. 02 E. 130 feet to the point of beginning. This being lot #4 as shown on a plat of file at judgment sale #445 and being all of three lots conveyed to said corporation by W. G. Ross as attorney for Mary R. Chappley and as Executor of Hiram L. Ross deceased executed 17th 1919 deed to which is of record in do. 65 page 173 to part of the consideration for this deed the grantor assumes and agrees to pay a mortgage in the sum of \$45,250.00 bearing date December 1st 1919 with interest thereon, now due given to W. G. Ross as attorney and executor by the grantor to secure a portion of the purchase price of said lands. Said mortgage is of record in the R.M.C. Office in Val. 45 page 288

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and
his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
