KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Pelzer Manufacturing Co.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Pelzer in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred and Two and 50/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto R. M. Lollis.

All that tract of land situated in Oak Lawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Saluda River and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the road leading from Pelzer to Arden; thence S. 20.15 W. 46.19 to Saluda River; thence up the River about 70 chains to an iron pin on bank of River; thence N. 65 E. 10.40 to white oak; thence N. 43 E. 14.08 to iron pin; thence with line of H. M. Rice S. 18.20 E. 5.94 to corner; thence S. 42.15 E. 11.36 to beginning corner, containing one hundred and thirty and 65/100 (130 65/100) acres, more or less. See plat of H. J. Kollock April 1, 1920, P. M. C. Plat Book - page - 44. Expressly reserving and not hereby conveying the rights as it now exists, before the execution of this deed, in the Pelzer Manufacturing Company to overflow any part of said premises with the waters of Saluda River or other contributing streams by reason of the dam of Pelzer Manufacturing Company as now constructed or as it may be raised by said Company or its assigns at its pleasure at any time hereafter, and also the right to enter upon said premises when and where necessary or convenient for the purpose of repairing, inspecting or enlarging the property or works of the said Company.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

Subject to the conditions and reservations hereinbefore set forth.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Subject to the conditions and reservations hereinbefore set forth.

on this the 1st day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Twenty and in the one hundred and Forty-fourth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
