KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

O.G. Fickel of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of *One thousand* DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *B.A. Morgan and J.W. Steele*

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

B.A. Morgan and J.W. Steele, their heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being, in Chickasawhaw Township, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the Sandy Flat Road, East of Parie Mountain, containing twenty acres more or less, and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on a stone on the sandy flat Road, thence S. 47 1/4 E. 1223 to a stone, thence N. 50 1/2 E. 5.50 to a stone, thence N. 187.15.25 to a junction, thence N. 40-1/2 W. 6.70 to a stone, thence S. 71 1/2 W. 6.20 to a stone, thence S. 7-1/2 E. 13.05 to the beginning point on aforesaid stone, being the same tract of land of my late wife, Mrs. Ethel Hunt and W.T. Henderson by deed dated 14th day of September, 1912, and recorded in R.M.C. of Deed for Greenville County, Vol. 21, page 274. As a part of the consideration wherein I granted the said B.A. Morgan and J.W. Steele hereby agree to assume and pay the amount due by me and mortgage of Seven hundred fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, on said land, given by the said O.G. Fickel on September 14th, 1912, to W.T. Henderson and Ethel Hunt, and duly assigned by them to Mrs. Valarie Pickman, who is now legal owner and holder of same.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

B.A. Morgan and J.W. Steele, their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND..... do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

B.A. Morgan and J.W. Steele, their heirs and assigns, against ~~me and my~~ and every other heir, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
