is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. R. Jones and W. R. Hale: All that certain lot, piece or tract of land lying, being and situate in State and County aforesaid, containing three (3) acres, more or less, being a portion of the lands formerly owned by M.E. McCarter, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J.I. West by J.S.-Elmore by deed dated January 3rd. 1912, and recorded in Vol. 17, page 116, in office of Register of Meane Conveyance for Greenville County, S.C. The said tract having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the junction of the Spartanburg and Pelhams Road and running thence N. 83.45 E. 640 feet to a stone; thence S. 18 W. 438 feet to a stone; thence N. 59 W. 640 feet to the beginning corner.
