 being in the Town of Greers, Greenville County, in State aforesaid, and has the following
 courses, metes, bounds and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stake on north side of
 Cemetery Street at intersection of a new Street and runs thence with new Street N. 70
 W. two hundred feet to stake thence N. 27-1/2 E. fifty feet to B.O. Woodward corner, thence
 S. 73 E. two hundred feet to a stake Woodward corner on Cemetery Street, thence S. 27-1/2 W.
