Sterling, all that piece parcel or lot of land situated in the city of Greenville on north side of Perry Ave containing 200 square feet more or less, beginning on corner on Perry Ave; thence along Perry Avenue S. 45° E. fourteen feet to an iron pin on Perry Ave; thence N. 18½ E. 200 ft. to iron pin, thence N. 71½ W. 14 ft. to iron pin, thence S. 8½ W. 200 ft. to the beginning corner, part lot adjoining the lot described below and is the same lot surveyed to me by J. O.
