Myers. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

George M. Myers, one that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the Fifth Ward of the city of Greenville, in the county of Greenville and state of South Carolina having the following number and boundaries, to wit, Beginning at Mrs. M. K. McNeil's line on Main street and running thence in a north-westerly direction along said street, fifty seven and one half (57 1/2) feet to line of lot of Sykes; thence with line of said Sykes' lot in a south-westerly direction one hundred and ninety (190) feet to a stake on Hildreth's line; thence with said Hildreth's line in a south-easterly direction fifty-seven and one-half (57 1/2) feet to a stake on Mrs. M. L.
