Wyatt N. Johnson - all that certain parcel and lot of land situated, lying and
being in the State and County aforesaid, in the Town of Greenville, Chickasaw Springs
Community, on the South side of Moore St. and West side of Wyatt St. and having
the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at stake, corner of Moore
and Wyatt Streets, and thence S. 12° 58' E. 130.6 feet to a stake on alley
thence S. 16° 13' W. 75 feet to a stake; thence N. 12° 58' W. 128.4 feet to a stake
on said Moore Street; thence N. 74° 30' E. 75 feet to the beginning of corner, being
