Articles of agreement made this April 10, 1916, by and between Hattie Williams and E. W. Biggs, witnesseth:

That Hattie Williams dees put said E. W. Biggs into possession of a house and lot in ward # two (2), City of Greenville, at the corner of Elford and Brown Streets, having a frontage on Brown Street of fifty eight (58) feet, and running back on hundred (100) feet deep by the same side line as appear in deed to John H. Oneal by A. B. D wis and A. E. Boyd, recorded in R.M.C. Office, Volume five, page #36, the let hereby agreed to be conveyed being a part of said let recorded in R.M.C. Office, volume #5, page #36.

That the said E. W. Biggs hereby acknowledge that he is indebted to Hattie Williams on account of the purchase price of said house and lot in the sum of twenty-two hundred fifty dellars, (\$2250.00) to be paid as fellows: Three hundred dellars, (\$300.00) this day paid in cash, the receipt whereef is hereby acknowledged, and two hundred dellars (\$200.00) to be paid within sixty days (60), from date with no interest in the defered payment of two hundred dellars (\$200.00), but the balance, seventeen hundred and fifty dollars (\$1750.00), is to be paid in quaterly instalments, every three menths, beginning with the first three month period from date, to be paid seventy-five dellars (\$75.00 quaterly with interest on the unpaid principal at the rate of eight per cent per annum until paid, and the said E. W. Biggs agrees to pay all taxes, insur ance and repairs and legal assessments against said property from date.

It is further agreed that upon the payment by said E. W. Biggs, of at least one thousand dollars (\$1000.00), on the principal of the debt, exclusive of interest, insurance and taxes, and cost of repairs, that the said Hattie Williams will make to the said E. W. Biggs, a good title in fee sim# ple, upon the execution by the said E.W. Biggs of a note secuted by a mortgage on said premises, and an insurance policy on said house, for the balance of the principal, said note to bear interest t at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum, and to be payable one hear from the date of the note, together with te per cent (10%) attorney's fee in case of collection by suit.

It is further agreed that the full amount of the parchase price under this contract shall be paid within five (5) years, and such part thereof as remains unpaid at the end of five years under the installment plan herein contemplated, shall immediately mature and become payable and collectible

It is further agreed that if the said E.W. Biggs fails to keep and perform the bbligations stipulated in this bond, then that all money paid by him shall be applied as rent for the possession of said place, and as liquidated damages for the breach of said contract, and he shall be treated and considered as a tenant holding over after the expiration of his term, and shall surrender possession upon due notice.
