that said regimental Streets as laid out through the property leased for the bemefit of the Government may be extended along straight lines to the forty (40) foot road above mentioned. And said Realty Corporation does hereby grant unto A.L. Mills, as President of Greenville Chamber of Commerce, his successors in office and assigns, a right of ingress and egress over and along the said four streets or roads, for the use of the United States Government in connection with camps for training troops or other military purposes, and for the use of the public,.

Such streets or roads may be kept open and unobstructed so long as the tract first above mentioned shall be used for government purposes.

upon and if such cannot be arrived at, then the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the holder of this Option and the two so appointed, will select the third. The decision of any two of the three arbitrators to be final. Any damage to buildings shall be settled for in the same manner.

The Government may remove the timber upon the land or so much thereof as it desires at its own cost. The market value thereof to be paid me in addition to the said rental to be determined by arbitration as above provided if necessary.
