Whereas, James Scott died August 31st, 1914, leaving of full force his last will and testament, which was duly proven in the Court of Probate for Greenville County on the 7th, day of Sept. 1914. And Whereas, he devised his "Home Place" subject to certain life estate, to us, John M. Scott, J.Allen Scott, and Robert E.
