Loftis of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Fifteen & 00/100 dollars to -- in hand paid by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of F.C. Jeter on the north, J.D. Garrett on the west, A.H. Whitmire on the South and A. Bradley on the east and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances, a pipe line for the purpose of conveying water under pressure, from the auxiliary pumping station on the Enoree River to the main pipe line leading to the City, from reservoir number three, of the Paris Mountain Water Co., together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line, and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line, all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of the same. The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said easement. Any damages to crops planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if such can not be arrived at mutually, the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the holder of this grant, and the two so appointed, to select a third.

The decision of any two of the three arbitrators shall be final.

Johnson of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Three & 00/100 dollars to me in hand paid by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Mrs. Jones on the north, Batson estate on the east, W.F. Roberts on the South and T.J. Rainey on the west and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and telephone service, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line, and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said easement. Any damages to crops planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if such can not be arrived at mutually, the damages shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the holder of this grant, and the two so appointed, to select a third.

The decision of any two of the three arbitrators shall be final.

The above amount is paid for one pole and if any more poles are places on the above premises I am to receive three dollars for each additional pole.
