Schuring, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Charles F. Schuring, his heirs and assigns forever an undivided one half interest, of all my interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, fronting on College Street and abutting the following streets, lines and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Laurens Street running at a stake on Laurens Street running thence westward along Laurens Street N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 135 feet & 9 inches to a stake at the corner of Laurens and College Street, thence with said College Street to a stake at the corner of College and Richardson Street, thence with said Richardson Street S. 19 W. 175 feet and 5 inches to a stake measured Street.
