is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.C. Milford, All that certain tract of land situate partly in Greenville County and partly
in Laurens County, in the State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone on Horse Creek, J.C. Milford's corner and running thence with J.C. Milford's
line N. 52 E. 18.13 ch. to a stone; thence with line of tract conveyed by C.F. Haynsworth to
J.C. Milford N. 31 W. 27.75 ch. to a S.O.; thence still with line of tract heretofore conveyed
by C.F. Haynsworth to J.C. Milford N. 9 1/2 W. 12.20 to a stone on road; thence S. 7 3/4 W. 8.10 ch.
