KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, J. R. Earle of the County ofGreenville

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Five Hundred Dollars and other consideration

to

at and before the sealing of these presents by T. W. Honour

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

T. W. Honour, All that certain tract of land in the State and  
County aforesaid, along three miles West of the City of Greenville, and  
the State of Saluda river, in Greenville Township, bounded by  
lands of R. G. Williams, T. W. Honour, Dr. White, Louise Earle and  
others and beginning at a red oak tree on the west side of a  
road, running thence across said road South 29° 46' E. 146.5 feet  
to an iron pipe on Dr. White's line; thence South 26° 17' East 858.1  
feet to an iron pipe; thence along Louise Earle's line South  
164.27 feet 630.5 feet; thence South 58.27 West 387.6 feet, thence  
South 38.57 West 295.6 feet; thence North 86.27 West 294.3, thence  
running across the said road North 28° 38' West 703.1 feet, thence  
north 30° 29' 76.792 feet to a stone R. G. Williams corner, thence  
with Williams' line North 50° 11' East 830 feet to Honour's  
corner, thence with Honour's line South 40° 46' East 486  
feet, thence continuing with Honour's line North 83.13  
East 752.1 feet to the beginning corner, containing fifty-  
one and 76/100 (51.70) acres more or less, being one of the tracts  
of land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, Master, in the partition  
of my father's estate, (John R. Earle), deed recorded in the  
R.M.C. office for said Greenville County in Deed Book 722 U  
page 20. Said tract was conveyed in two different parcels  
to said John R. Earle, my father, one from Adam Reed, deed  
recorded in Vol. EEE, page 540, twenty-eight acres, one from  
May Yawn, deed recorded in Vol. 424 page 300, twenty-two  
acres. May Yawn conveyed the same twenty-eight acres,  
to Adam Reed, deed recorded in Vol. XX, page 4492; G. M.  
Hasper conveyed to May Yawn this same tract of land,  
deed recorded in Vol. P.A. page 72; R. L. Cheshire conveyed to  
G. M. Jasper, deed recorded in Vol. PP, page 67, S. J. Southit  
conveyed to R. L. Cheshire, November 13th, 1880. John Bringle  
and others conveyed to S. J. Southit, deed recorded in Vol.  
E E, page 630. All of said land was made by W. Olin  
Jones, July, 1913; the above description is in accordance with  
said gift.
