at and before the sealing of these presents by Robert E. and Beas^d Benson

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
Robert E. and Beas^d Benson.

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, situate
 lying and being in the town of Travelers Rest,
 Greenville County and State aforesaid about ten
 north of the city of Greenville, S.C. and on the west
 side of the M^E Elhancey Road, adjoining lands of J. E.
 Watson, Church lot, J. R. Cooper and G. W. Bridwell,
 and having the following metes and bounds to wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on the M^E Elhancey
 road corner of the parsonage lot and running
 thence N. 49. W. 2. 88 chs. to an iron pin N. N. 38 thence
 N. 24. W. 3. 17 chs. to an iron pin N. 38; thence N. 41 E. 1. 88 chs.
