J. V. Turner, all that certain tract of land being in
 Fairview Township, County of Greenville, State aforesaid,
 and lying on east side of Sandy River near Fork, should
 ridge abut on north side Fountain Inn Road, containing
 fifteen & one-half acres (15.00) more or less, with following
 fixtures and bounds:— Common civic centre said river head
 (L. L. Cupblins come) 75 links to river from on back side
 wood trees by witness, thence parallel with R. R. Turnings
 line (one (1) chain and 25 links from same) S. 16° E. 11.20
 chains to stone on hill, thence S. 13° 47' 20" minutes N. 6.34
 to stone, thence S. 63° 44' W. 7.75 to river over pipe in Fountain
 Inn road, opposite Goldsmith Avenue, see iron link
