is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Joseph Dickson, all of our right, title and  
interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel  
outlot of land situate lying and being on the out-  
side of the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville  
in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,  
and having the following metes and bounds as  
shown by survey made by W. C. Dalton, Surveyor March  
13, 1917: Commencing at an iron pipe on North side  
of Loc street, corner of estate of Ben Earle; thence  
along the north side of Loc Street N. 64-42 W. 148.5  
feet to an iron pipe corner of John Adair lot

feet to an iron pipe on line of the Meane prop-
