is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

P. G. Moore, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the Mostella Road and run thence S. 88 1/4 E. 31.06 chs. to a stone, thence N. 5 E. 15.10 chs. to a stone, thence N. 86 1/2 W. 31.72 chs. to a stone on the said Mostella Road, thence with the road N. 74 chs. to beginning corner, containing 36 acres, more or less.

Also all that other piece, parcel or tract of land situated as aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a corner on Mostella Road and run thence with said road N. 35 chs. to a stone, thence S. 89 1/4 E. 7 chs. to a stone, thence S. 3 E. 14.35 chs. to a stone, thence N. 61 1/4 E. 8 1/2 chs. to a pin, thence N. 88 W. 7 chs. to beginning corner, containing 7 acres, more or less.
