is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E. Melton, wife, that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing the following described boundaries: Beginning at a stone set in the middle of the National Highway S. 34° 44' E. division of the said E. Melton tract, corner of lot number 74, and running thence along said National Highway N. 60° 16' E. twenty-five feet to a stake, and from said National Highway add corner of lot number 76, thence S. 24° 44' W. fifty feet to a stake in the line of lot number 73, thence running along line of said lot number 73 S. 60° 16' W. twenty-five feet to a stake in said line and corner of lot number 74, thence S. 24° 44' E. fifty feet to a stake at the beginning corner, then lot being numbered 75 of said said division, Plat of said tract made by C. Melton & Son, Surveyor, the 20th of June 1917, and is recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County in Plat Book 12 at page 50.
