Marchbanks, the following described real estate, to-wit:-

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, on Wilton Street and Randall Street and being lots nos. 25, 27 and 29 of Section "B" of a plat of the Stone Land Company, said plat recorded in R. M. L. Office in Plat Book "D", pages 337-345. Said lots having a frontage on Wilton Street of two hundred feet and on Randall Street of three hundred twenty six and three tenths feet"

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Rosa H. Marchbanks, her heirs and assigns forever.
