all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in ward six of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and having a frontage of seventy-five feet on Hardington Street and having a depth on one side of one hundred sixty-one feet and a depth on the other side of one hundred sixty-five feet and having a width of fifty-eight and one-half feet in the rear and being known and designated as lot no. 222 according to a subdivision and plat of the P. S. Cox Estate made by W. A. Adams February 2nd, (1917).
