on or about the 4th day of August in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seventeen exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Myrtle Elena Fuller.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 16th day of August 1917, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. F. McCauley

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. _____)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said W. F. McCauley,

all the right, title and interest of Myrtle Elena Fuller in and to the following described real estate, to-wit: All those two certain parcels or tracts of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the head waters of Enoree River and run as follows: Beginning at a stone 34, Crain's corner, thence S. 35 N. 13.40 chs. to a stone, thence N. 72 N. 17.38 chs. to a stone 34, Huff's line; thence N. 18-3/4 E. 6.89 chs. to a stone; thence S. 89 E. 22.06 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing seventeen (17) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of Venice Pool and Stephen Pool, Wm. Huff and others.

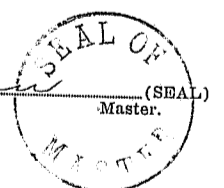
Second lot lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and beginning at the west side of the Greenville Road and run as follows: Beginning at a stake at the corner, thence N. 72 N. 7.49 chs. to a stone, 34; thence N. 33 E. 13.90 chs. to a stone 34 0m; thence S. 72 E. 4.55 chs. to a stake in Greenville Road; thence with said road S. 24 N. 13.36 to the beginning corner, and adjoining lands of W. M. Spencer, T. J. Pool, T. P. Pool and others, containing ten (10) acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to W. F. Fuller by Ellena Williams by deed dated June 22, 1899, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. in Book 554 at page 606.
