Myers in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, containing one hundred and forty-one (141) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of John F. Kearns, estate Mrs. L. P. White, A. C. Hampton, C. W. Ellis, and others in Garret Township, and about six miles from City of Greenville.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

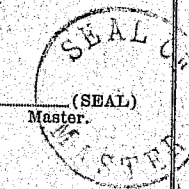
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said George M. Myers his heirs and assigns forever.
