TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Georgia A. Williams

on or about the 5th, day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eighteen exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Etta Ione Williams

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th, day of April 1918, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W.S. Batson

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)
NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, & upon payment of \$1500.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

W.S. Batson the entire interest of the plaintiff and of the defendant in and to all that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, fronting on Stall Street fifty (50) feet, with a depth of one-hundred twenty (120) feet having the following lines: Beginning at a stake on Stall Street eighty (80) feet from the southeast corner of David and Stall Streets; thence with Stall Street South 66-1/4 West fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence parallel with David Street South 22-3/4 East one hundred twenty (120) feet to a stake; thence along line parallel with Stall Street North 66-1/4 East fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence along line parallel with David Street North 22-3/4 West one hundred twenty (120) feet to the beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said W.S. Batson, his heirs and assigns forever.
